A. _____ I intend to pursue the California State license as a Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT). I understand that:

- 1. I will need to participate in a clinical placement and obtain 300 hours of practicum experience (direct client service-200 individual hours and 100 relational hours) plus 75 hours of client-centered advocacy as part of the Master of Marriage and Family Therapy degree.
- 2. I will be allowed to participate in an approved clinical placement and collect clinical hours after I have been designated as a Trainee by the school.
- 3. I will need to submit additional documentation when registering for an associate number if I have been convicted of, or pled guilty or nolo contendere to, any misdemeanors or felonies or if I have been denied a professional license and I may not be able to qualify for state licensure.

B. _____ I intend to pursue another state title as a practicing therapist. I will complete at least 300 hours of practicum experience plus 75 hours of client-centered advocacy and will be responsible for knowing and adhering to that state's current licensing/ certification requirements. I will complete the required practicum/graduation experience required for my Master of Marriage and Family Therapy Degree from Phillips Graduate Institute, Los Angeles Education Center of Campbellsville University.
